Things to remember in Reception

- During the Summer term in reception, the children will start to change into PE kits for their PE lessons. This will enable them to develop their independence ready for year 1. PE Kits (shorts, T-shirt and pumps) and bags can be purchased from the school office for a small charge. Please ensure names are written inside all clothing. Bags will be kept in school and sent home for washing in the holidays.
- Our library day is Friday. Children can select a book to take home and share with their parents/carers. Books must be returned the following Friday so that they can be changed. Children will need their blue book bag. Individual reading books will go home weekly and must be with your child everyday as reading days may change.
- Please get involved in your child's learning journey by accessing our online tool, "Tapestry". Just ask one of us if you are unsure.
- Class dojo is a great way to see the rewards your child has had at school. We also share news, photos and messages. If you haven't signed up to access it yet, please ask a member of the team.

Learning in Year Reception:

In <u>writing</u>

- Use phonic knowledge to write words that match their spoken sounds.
- Write some common irregular words.
- Write sentences that can be read by ourselves and others.

-In guided reading and phonics

- Continue to learn and consolidate Phase 3 and 4 letters, sounds and tricky words.
- To read and understand simple sentences.
- Decode unfamiliar words using our phonic knowledge and read some common irregular words and answer questions about the texts we are reading

In <u>numeracy</u>

- Count order and say one more/less from numbers one-20. Develop methods and strategies to add and subtract two single digit numbers practically. Solve problems involving doubling, halving and sharing. Begin to count in two's and tens.


- Use everyday and mathematical language to talk about shape, size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money.
