Key activities and skills for Summer term:

In Year 3 our Summer topic is: 'Celtic and Roman Life'. We will begin by exploring what Celtic life in Britain was like. We will examine what homes and daily life were like throughout Britain at this time. We will also start to think about what might have attracted the Romans to travel to Britain. We will then move on to consider the Roman invasion and what the positive benefits of the occupation were for the country. We will have a fantastic trip to Chester and on this exciting day will spend time in the gallery looking at Roman artefacts, take part in an archaeology workshop and go on a Roman march around Chester.

- In Literacy we are continuing to focus on our writing skills. This term we will be writing stories based on the picture books of Anthony Browne, recounts of our trip to Chester and stories based on Roman Myths and Legends. Spelling is a continued challenge that we will be working on and I will be sending home more spelling based homework activities.
- In Numeracy the children will be continuing to secure their Year 3 maths skills. We will be working on all four operations (+, -, x and ÷) and focusing in on using these to solve problems.


How to help your child at home:
