Learning in Year One:

In writing

Non - fiction - We will be writing labels, captions and lists on our topic theme 'All About Me'.

We will learn how to say, sequence and write instructions for everyday processes such as washing our hands and cooking.

Fiction - We will read and learn stories with familiar settings and write our own simple story based on stories shared in class.

Poetry - We will write descriptive poems based on what we can see, hear, smell, touch and taste

Please encourage your child to keep writing over the Summer holidays to keep up the great work that they have achieved in Reception.

In guided reading

We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts

- We will use phonics to work out unknown words in texts
- We will learn to recognise and read tricky words
- We will talk about what we have read and learn how to retell stories in the correct order and find information in non-fiction books

In numeracy

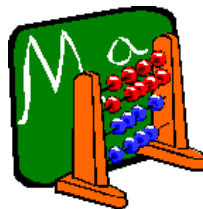
We will be learning.....

Numbers & Counting: count to 100, count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's, count forwards and backwards, say the number that is 1 more / 1 less

Understand addition & subtraction: read and write number sentences, use number bonds to 10 / 20, solve one step problems, find money totals

Shape: know names of 2D & 3D shapes and describe some properties

Measures: compare length / height / weight & capacity, use simple measuring equipment, understand and use vocabulary related to time

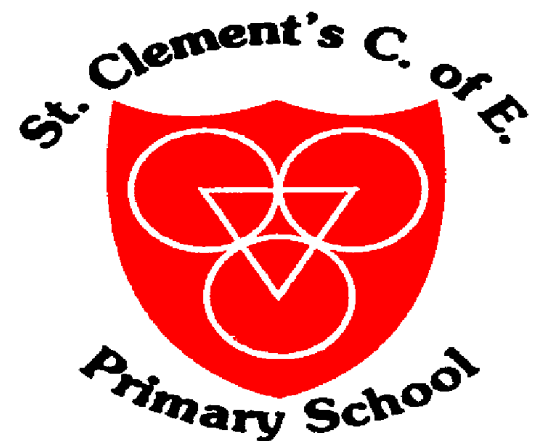
