

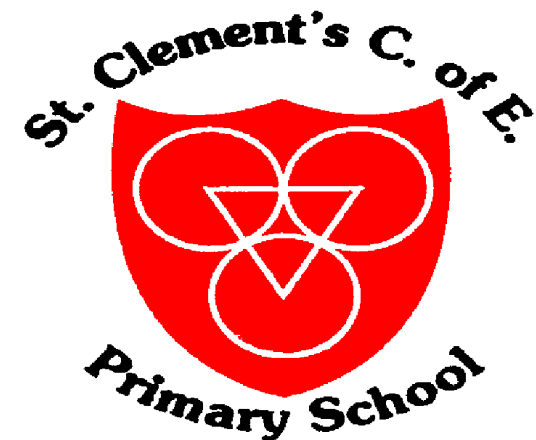
Things to remember in Year Five:

- Homework is given out on a Friday and must be returned by the date stated on the sheet. Homework is usually project based now, and can last 3 weeks. We will also be focusing on developing effective test techniques for reading tests and developing our comprehension skills.
- In numeracy: We will continue to develop our Rapid recall skills and our problem solving skills. We will be developing effective test techniques, so we feel more confident in test conditions. We will also be learning to love fractions/decimals and percentages and secure our learning within this area!
- In Topic: Our topic this term is 'Out of this World'. We will be looking at life in Space, the solar system and developments in the space frontier.
- Please make sure your child is in the playground by 8.50am, ready to learn because we start our lessons as soon as we walk into class.
