- Please encourage your child to continue to read a wide range of texts/books at home—this will enhance their reading skills further and

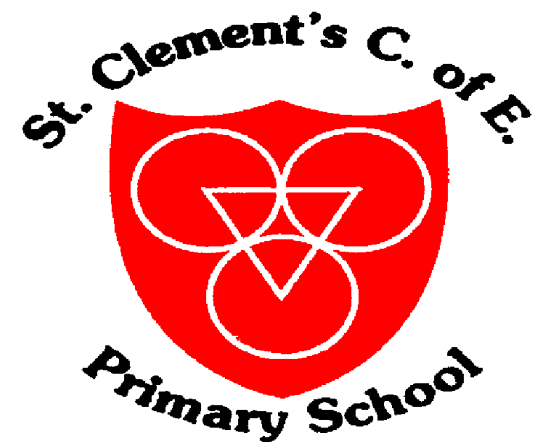
Learning in Year 4:

To begin Year 4 our first topic is 'Vicious Vikings'. In this unit we will meet The Vikings. At home with the Vikings we will find out where they were from and we will learn about their homes and buildings. The children will also discover that Vikings were explorers and raiders. We will find out where they explored, how they used long boats to get there and we will be describing Viking raids.

In literacy this term we will be looking at myths as well as stories set in imaginary worlds. It will continue to be very important for the children to write using a range of interesting and adventurous word choices and we will work hard to make our punctuation accurate. A key skill we will be working on this term is spelling and it is important that all children work hard to practise and learn the spellings that they are given.

In guided reading we will continue to read many different types of text. We will continue our journey to develop the children's enjoyment of reading and hope that you will continue to encourage your child to read as much as possible for pleasure, both at home and in school.
