Learning in Year 4:

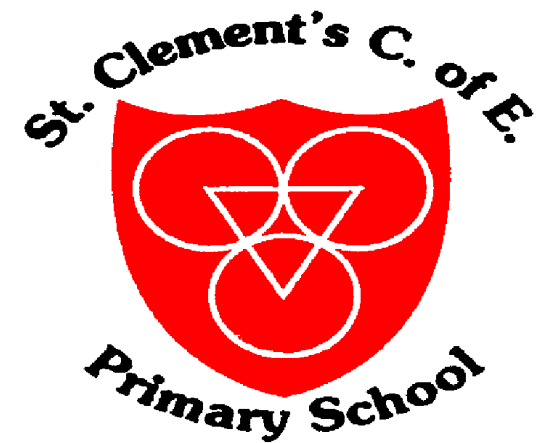
