#### Things to remember in Year One:

- I have PE once a week and my PE kit must be in school EVERYDAY. I need indoor and outdoor kit, including footwear. Our PE day is Thursday.
- I have a new reading book once a week. I must bring my reading book and Reading Record in EVERY DAY.
- Reading is very important but I won't get better at it if I don't practice EVERY DAY with an adult or an older sibling. If I read at home everyday—and get my record signed— then I will get 5 Clems to spend in the Reading Shop.

### Learning in Year One:



<u>Non-Fiction</u> - We will be writing recounts and holiday reviews based on our topic 'Where in the World'

<u>Fiction</u> - We will read and learn stories from a wide range of cultures and traditions particularly India. We will write about characters and settings and compare these stories to the stories we already know.

#### In guided reading

In <u>writing</u>

We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts

- We will use phonics to work out unknown words in texts
- We will learn to recognise and read tricky words
- We will talk about what we have read and learn how to find the answers to simple questions in fiction and non—fiction books.



We will be learning......

In <u>numeracy</u>

Numbers & Counting: count to 100, count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's, count forwards and backwards, place numbers on a number line, understand and use the terms 'more' and 'less', 'partition' 'teen' numbers and other 2 digit numbers.

**Understand Calculations:** read and write number sentences, use number bonds to 10 / 20, solve one step problems, find money totals, be able to add 1 digit to 2 digit numbers. Use pictures, arrays and equipment to solve multiplication and division problems.



Time: recognise, find and name a half and a quarter of equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

**Measures:** compare length / height / weight & capacity, use simple measuring equipment, understand and use vocabulary related to time, tell the time to the hour, half hour and quarter hour, know months of the year and days of the week.

#### <u>Phonics in Year 1</u>

The children will continue to have a daily focussed phonics session in year 1. All children in Year 1 will be given a phonics test in June, called the Year 1 Phonics Check. We are practising reading 'alien words' in school and we hope that the children have been practising at home using their alien word boxes. Please continue to support this and bring your boxes back to school each week. This is to give the children the best possible chance when they come to take the test.
