Learning in Year 4:

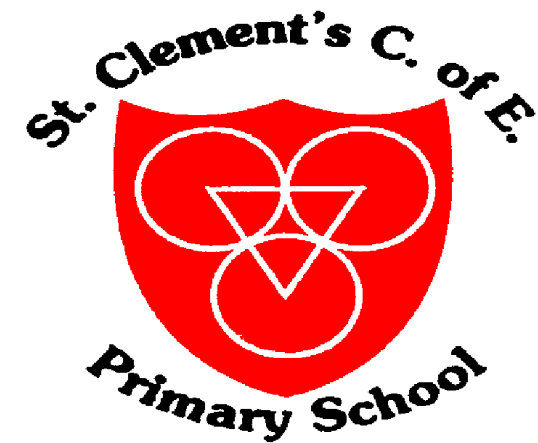

In literacy this term we will be looking at a range of genre around the Egyptian theme, including persuasive writing, instructions and non fiction texts. It will continue to be very important for the children to write using a range of interesting and adventurous word choices and we will work hard to make our punctuation accurate. A key skill we will be continuing with this term is spelling.

In guided reading we will continue to read many different types of text, specifically linked with Egypt. We will continue our journey to develop the children’s enjoyment of reading and hope that you will continue to encourage your child to read as much as possible for pleasure, both at home and in school.

In numeracy we will be focusing on times table, multiplication and shape. Please discuss different 2-d and 3-d shapes we see in the world around us, and practise times tables with your child.
