

### Things to remember in Year One:


- I have PE once a week and my PE kit must be in school **EVERYDAY**. I need indoor and outdoor kit, including footwear. Our PE day is Monday.
- I have a new reading book once a week. I must bring my reading book and Reading Record in **EVERY DAY**.
- Reading is very important but I won't get better at it if I don't practice **EVERY DAY** with an adult or an older sibling. I will get my clemis if I have read with an adult 5 times a week and my reading record is signed.

### Learning in Year One:

#### In writing:

**Non-Fiction** - We will be writing a recount of a trip to the woods/local park.

**Fiction** - We will read and learn about the traditional tale of Little red riding hood. We will write a new story from the perspective of the wolf.



#### In guided reading

We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts

- We will use phonics to work out unknown words in texts
- We will learn to recognise and read tricky words
- We will talk about what we have read and learn how to find the answers to simple questions in fiction and non-fiction books.




#### In Numeracy

We will be learning:

**Numbers & Counting:** count to 100, count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's, count forwards and backwards, place numbers on a number line, understand and use the terms 'more' and 'less', partition 'teen' numbers and other 2 digit numbers, find doubles and halves of numbers.

**Understand addition & subtraction:** read and write number sentences, use number bonds to 10 / 20, solve one step problems, find money totals, be able to add 1 digit to 2 digit numbers, understand simple fractions,

**Measures:** Understand vocabulary related to height and length.


