


Things to remember in Year 4:

- I have guided reading on **Wednesday** and will remember to bring in my book.
- I have swimming on **Thursday** afternoons.
- The expectation in Year 4 is that **everyone** will read for at least 15 minutes **every day**. This is **my homework every night**. My reading record needs to be in school every day and will be checked. If I have read I may receive CLEMs to spend in the CLEMs shop and get a dip in the box on Friday.
- Additional homework (KUNCU) may be sent. This will need to be returned in time for the next lesson (usually the next day). This is to help me keep up in lessons and make good progress.
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Learning in Year 4:

- **Spelling** continues to be a focus for us as we move into Spring Term. The children have all been given a little notebook and some coloured pencils to help them learn their spellings. Other strategies that may help are playing games such as scrabble or hangman, having a mini test at home or drawing pictures. Please help your child by allowing them access to paper and drawing materials. Do try to remember that spelling takes time—it cannot be learned just by copying words out but needs to be practised regularly.
- Learning apps have been provided for home use. These have been carefully chosen in order to help your child to make progress in their learning. Your child will have their own login and password for **Reading Buddy**, **Timetable Rockstars** and **Mathletics**. Children should try and use these if they can although we do appreciate that not every one has internet access or devices. If you do not have the internet and require paper practice materials please contact Ms Nichol or Miss O' Connor and we will be happy to help.
- Children have access to our Class library at school and may change their library book as often as they wish. In addition, they will receive a new guided book every week and may also access their Reading Buddy account. **Please ensure that all school reading books are returned to school.**
