Key activities for Summer 1 and 2 in Year Two:

We will begin working on our new topic "Wild About Animals"

- We will continue to learn about animals around the world looking very closely at and comparing habitats.
- We will visit Lytham St Annes and look at the history of the seaside and development of holidays
- We will be learning about maps and where different continents, countries and oceans are

Learning in Year Two:

In <u>writing</u> children focus on writing in clear and accurate sentences. We will look to add more detail, begin to use different punctuation, be aware of the different types of sentences, for e.g. command, statement, question and exclamation. We will also look to check our work using a dictionary.

In guided reading children will continue to work on comprehension skills, writing clear answers to questions about a text. Children will also be reading more chapter books.

In maths children will focus on fractions and time. We will also keep working on answering a range of questions and looking at ways we can find answers to questions and prove our answers with equipment and mathematical pictures. We will be learning our 2s, 5s, 10s, and 3 times tables. We will also be learning to count back in these sequences from any number.


Homework:
