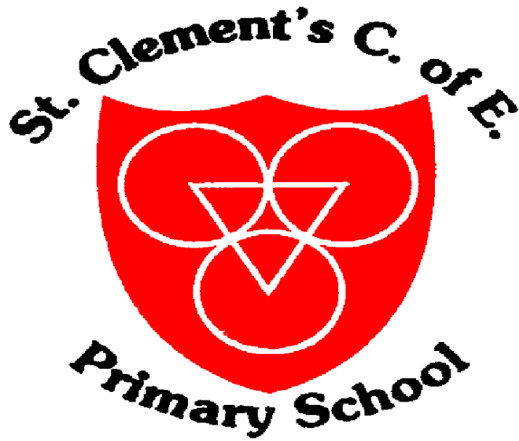

Things to remember in Year Five:

PE remains on a THURSDAY AFTERNOON. Children will need to come in in their PE kits in the morning. If there are any issues stopping your child from doing PE please get in touch via dojo or at the gate in the morning.

Children will get homework as and when required—this will either be individual for something they haven't quite got the hang of, or for the whole class for a research topic. Children should however be accessing TTrackstars and reading independently wherever possible—15 minutes a day makes a huge difference!

New reading books are given whenever required—children should be recording their progress in their reading records, which will be checked by Y5 staff.

Learning in Year Five:

In Literacy: We will be attempting a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, including information texts, diary entries, and discussion texts examining a range of opinions.

In guided reading: We will continue to use Assessment Domains to develop our love of reading systematically, and will be focusing on a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts to support our learning in other topics.

In numeracy: **This Term will be heavily focused on Shape and Geometry - this will include position and movement, area and different styles of measurement**

In Topic: Our topic this term is 'Magical Monarchs'. We will be examining rulers throughout history, comparing them and what they had to face and govern through!

The doors open at 8:45 and will close at 8:55— learning begins straight away in Y5 and missing this 10 minutes is an hour of learning lost a week! Please make sure your child is in in good time!
