

Learning in Year 3:

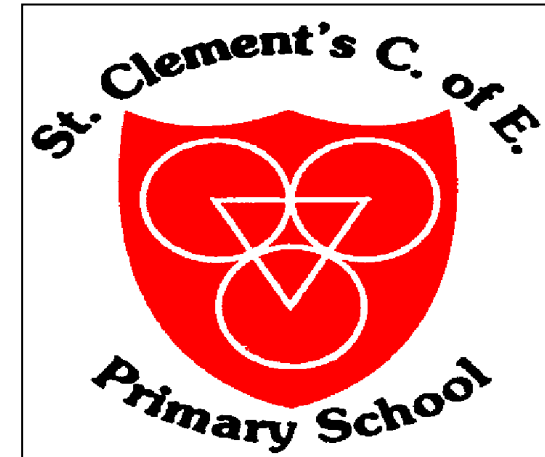
Our first topic is 'Rocks and Stones'. We will be learning about rocks and soils in our Science work. We will also be finding out about the Stone Age in our History lessons.

In Literacy: We will work on a range of stories, poetry and information texts. We will work on writing using a range of vocabulary and punctuation in our writing that shows we are writing for different audiences. A key skill we will be working on this term is spelling. We will continue to work on our phonics knowledge and build on this to learn spelling patterns and rules. It is important that all children work hard to practise and learn the spellings that they are given.

Things to remember in Year 3:

- I have guided reading once a week and I will bring my reading book and reading record into school every day to show what I have read.
- Please encourage your child to continue to read a wide range of texts/books at home—this will enhance their reading skills and vocabulary further and support them to improve their reading pace.
