Things to remember in Year Five:

- When we have PE (TBC), pease make sure that School PE kit is worn on this day
 with appropriate footwear. Our school PE kit is: red t—shirt, blue shorts / tracksuit bottoms.
- KUNCU homework will be given as and when needed for the child. This can be anything the staff have identified that the children need a little more help with. This will need to be completed and brought back to school THE NEXT DAY. One longer term project will be set per half term which will be designed to be completed over a number of weeks.
- Children have a new Reading book every week. They must bring their reading book
 and Reading Record in EVERY DAY for extra Dojo's and rewards. Children should
 be reading every night for at least 20 minutes.

Learning in Year Five:



In <u>writing</u> we will be focusing on quality, using all the skills we have learned, fluently and independently, in our writing. We will continue to focus on spelling as this is an area we really need to improve!

In <u>guided reading</u> — We will be focusing on a variety of text styles in fiction and non—fiction and we will use all our Reading Gems to develop our comprehension skills. Please ensure your child reads DAILY at home. They will have a new guided book every week and they are also free to choose a library book from our class library whenever they choose (one book at a time though!)



 In <u>Numeracy</u> we will begin with place value up to 1,000,000 before moving on to addition and subtraction. Every morning we will have Fast Maths to practise our skills in arithmetic and Rapid Reasoning to help develop our skills in problem solving.
