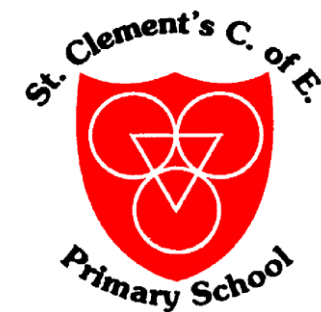

Parent/Carer Survey Feedback October 2023

In October, Parent/Carers were asked to complete our annual survey. Here are the results of the survey, some of the comments you made and some of the things that we will focus on.

-87 questionnaires were completed
 -Overwhelmingly positive response to all questions, but particularly questions 2, 13, 5, 14 & 1
 -Written comments were all positive and supportive.

-There were more strongly disagree responses this year.
 -The question with the most disagree responses (4) was question 10 - The school deals effectively with unacceptable behaviour.

Priorities for 2023-2024

- Improve pupils' outcomes in writing across the school.
- To make sure our curriculum is correctly sequenced so that children build up their knowledge and skills
- To reduce the % of pupils who are persistently absent (this is attendance that is below 90%).
- To provide parent/carers with guidance about how to support their child so that it impacts positively on their progress

2022-23 outcomes:

- Reception- Good Level of development dropped to 42%, so was less than local and national.
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check: 72% pupils passed. This was the same as local, but lower than the national phonics check results.
- KST1-Y2-Results: 77% of pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading; 58% in Writing and 68% in Maths.
- KST2- Y6 Results: 48% of pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths combined. Nationally it was 59%. 69% of pupils achieved expected or better in Reading; 55% in Writing and 65% in Maths.
