## <u>Things to remember in Year Three</u>

- We have PE twice a week—Tuesdays and Wednesdays and we need to make sure we bring in our complete P.E kits. This should be: red t -shirt, blue shorts with a plain tracksuit (preferably black) for colder weather. These should be kept in school where possible.
- Children will be sent home with KUNCU homework as and when necessary—however if this is not sent home we do expect children to be reading and practicing times tables or spellings every night.
- We will be bringing a book home from our class library regularly. However, please make sure you are reading a range of texts and record what you are reading in your Record books. It is important we are reading regularly, as remember—just 6 minutes a day can make a massive difference. Children are responsible for their own reading records and completing them


## Learning in Year Three:

- In <u>Writing</u> we are going to be developing our vocabulary skills in order to be able to select the most impactful language for writing for a variety of purposes. In Summer we'll be focusing on descriptive language, including Setting and Character—so get your children describing! What do they notice around them? How do people act in certain circumstances?
- In <u>Guided Reading</u>: Reading is incredibly important in Year 3 and we will be continuing to monitor and discuss reading habits of the children, including Reading Records. Every Wednesday morning, we have Book Talk where we talk about what we are reading and also swop our books if we want to change them. In our guided reading lessons we'll be continuing our focus on inference and retrieval, whilst working on prediction and definition to help us understand and develop our own writing.
- In <u>Numeracy</u> we will be looking at more abstract work building on our number skills. We'll be working on Time, Fractions, and Measurement of Angles! Time can be especially tricky so any help at all you can give at home is very much appreciated.
- The Topic this term is The <u>Wonderful World of Ancient Egypt</u>. This
