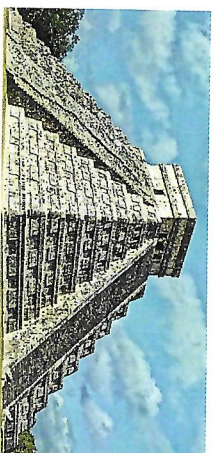


Topic: Summer 2024 Mayans Year 6
