Things to remember in Year Five:

- I need to bring my reading book and reading record in on Wednesday ready for our Book Talk sessions. I must independently complete my Reading Record, using my book talk prompts to help me.
- I have PE on Mondays and Wednesdays
- I get homework regularly, please check the due date and make sure it is in on time. Sometimes it will be a project homework, which could last 3 weeks.
- I can bring in a healthy snack from home every day. This could be a piece of fruit, a yogurt tube, raisins or something similar.
- It is expected that everyone in Year 5 will read every day. Everyone will have a guided book, and free access to our class library in order to facilitate this. Reading Records will be checked daily.
- Class staff can be contacted via Dojo, through the school office or more informally during drop off and pick up times. We are happy to make an appointment with you to discuss any questions or concerns you may have.

Learning in Year Five:

In <u>Literacy</u> this term we will be doing writing linked to a book called, 'The Promise'. We will be learning year 5 writing skills and practising applying them in our writing to help us become Awesome Authors!

In <u>Guided reading</u> we will continue to read a range of different text types, some linked to our Literacy Units. We will continue our journey to develop the children's enjoyment of reading and I hope that you will continue to encourage your child to read as much as possible for pleasure, both at home and in school.

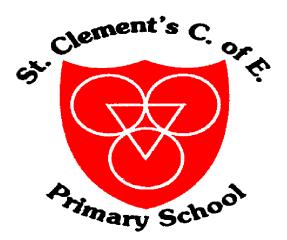
In Numeracy we will begin with place value up to 1,000,000 before moving on to
