

Parent/Carer Survey Feedback Autumn 2025

In the Autumn, Parent/Carers were asked to complete our annual survey. Here are the results of the survey, some of the comments you made and some of the things that we will focus on.

-72 questionnaires were completed

-Overwhelmingly positive response to all questions, but particularly questions 1, 2, 5, 13 & 14.

-Vast majority of written comments were all positive and supportive.

-There were very few disagree & strongly disagree responses again this year.

Priorities for 2025-26

- Increase opportunities to recap and recall previous learning
- To develop pupil's speaking and listening skills across the curriculum
- Play Based Learning is developed in Years 1 & 2 to develop pupil's independence, decision making skills and increase their wellbeing.
- Pupils actively support the wellbeing of other pupils.

2024-25 outcomes:

- Reception- Good Level of development was 50%.
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check: 73% pupils passed. This was an increase on 2024 and in line with local phonics check results.
- KST1-Y2-Results: 57% of pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading; 50% in Writing and 57% in Maths.
- KST2- Y6 Results:
58% of pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths combined. Nationally it was 62%.
74% of pupils achieved expected or better in Reading; 61% in Writing and 71% in Maths.
