

Key activities for Summer 1 and 2 in Year Two:

We will begin working on our new topic "Wild About Animals"

- We will learn about animals around the world looking very closely at and comparing habitats.
- We will visit Martin Mere Wetlands Centre to help with our learning about habitats.
- We will visit the local park to look at different local habitats.

Learning in Year Two:

In writing children focus on writing in clear and accurate sentences. We will look to add more detail, begin to use different punctuation, they will become more aware of the different types of sentences, for e.g. command, statement, question and exclamation. We will also work on our editing and improving skills.

In guided reading children will continue to work on comprehension skills, writing clear answers to questions about what they have read. We will be focusing on the key skills of retrieval, understanding vocabulary and defining words and inference.

In maths children will focus on money, fractions and measurement. We will be revisiting addition, subtraction specifically exchanging when the numbers cross the 10, multiplication and division. We will also keep working on answering a range of questions and looking at ways we can find answers to problems and prove our answers with equipment and mathematical pictures.



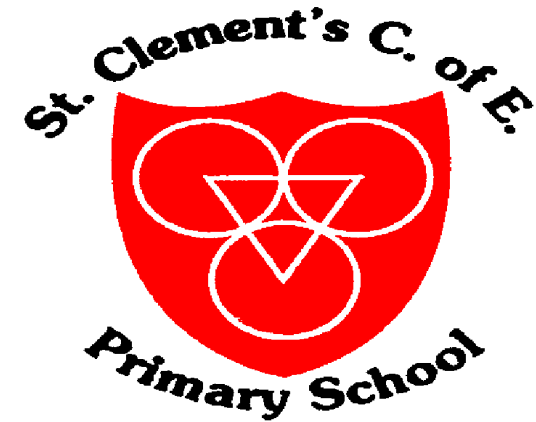
Homework:
